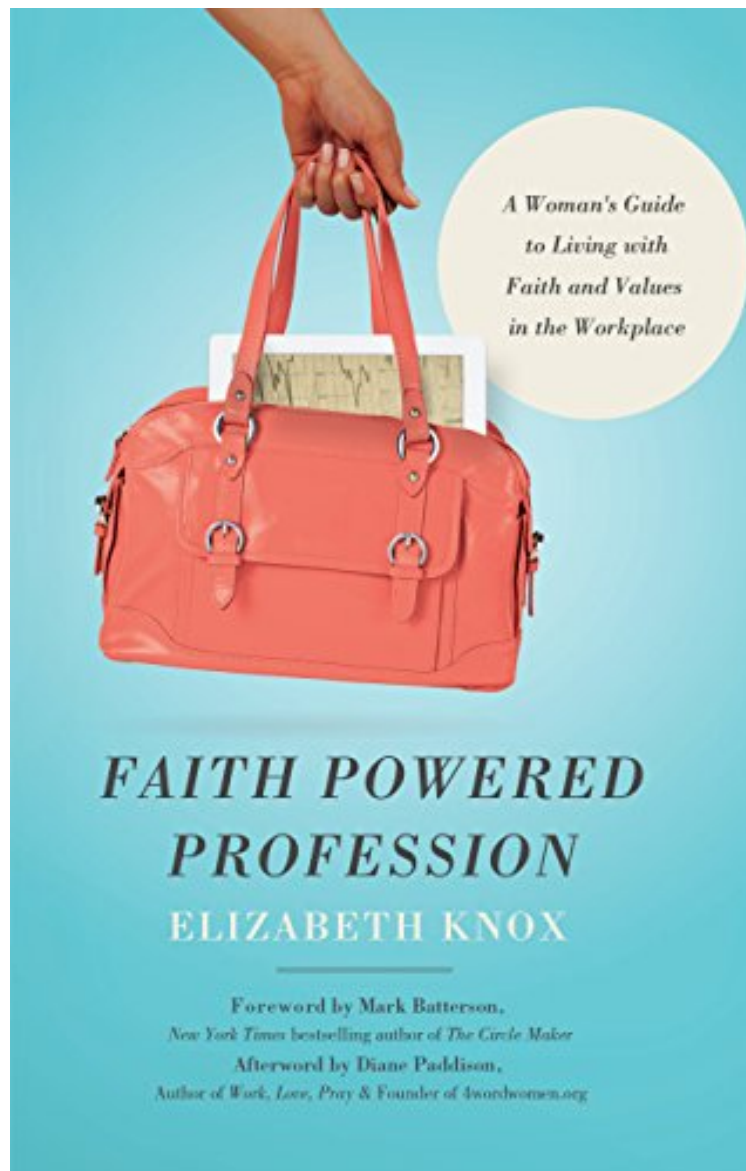

By Michael Stumborg The title and target audience for this book might cause you to disregard the observations and advice provided if you are not both a woman and a Christian, but it should not. The hard-won wisdom the author imparts from her own workplace experience is applicable if you are a woman, but is germane to those of us who have women coworkers. It sings to you if you are a Christian, but is also applicable if you are not devout, or are a member of another faith that just wants to lead an exemplary life in a mixed-gender workplace following time honored values (that just so happen to also be the foundation of Christian ethics). Elizabeth Knox does of course take it to the next level and provide guidance and insight directly focused on, and applicable only to, Christian professional women. I know young women in the workplace who struggle with the same challenges. After reading this book I suspect that I know others who struggle in silence. I don't have the experience and world view Elizabeth Knox brings to the discussion, so I don't feel qualified to advise them on how to deal with that. But I can buy them this book, and I will.
