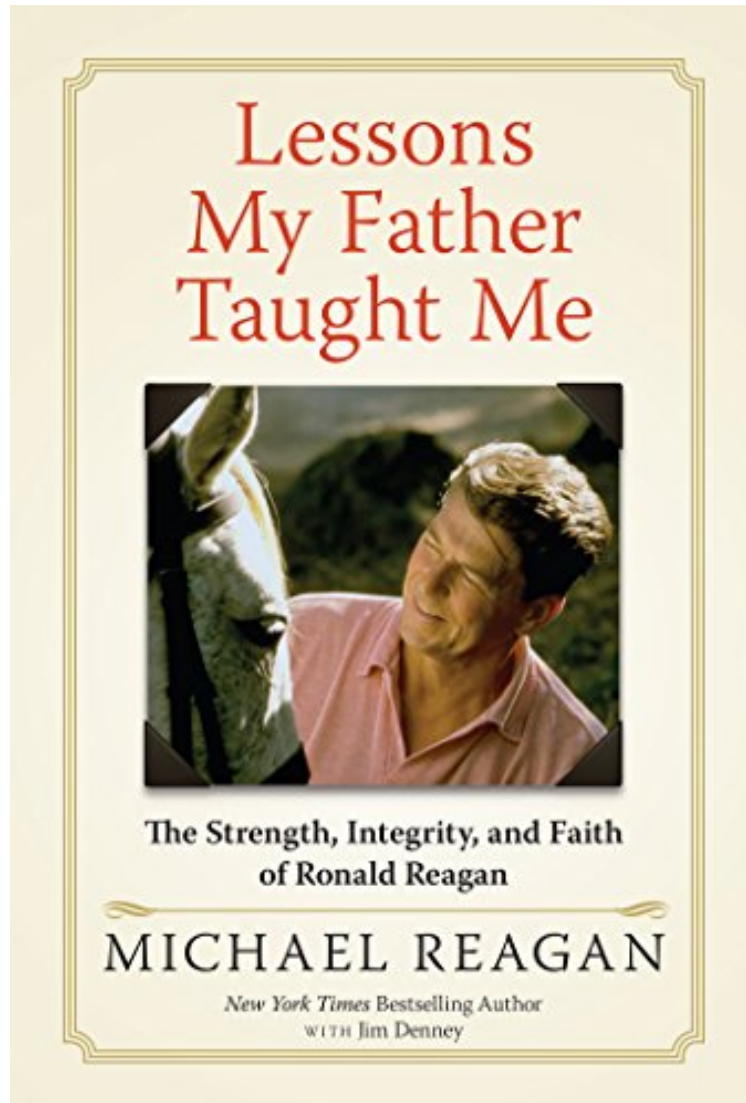

That led to his primary motivation to be president—so he could fight and defeat Soviet communism. Michael Reagan believes his father didn't win the Republican nomination in 1976 because none of his allies—Margaret Thatcher, Pope John Paul II, and others—were in place.
