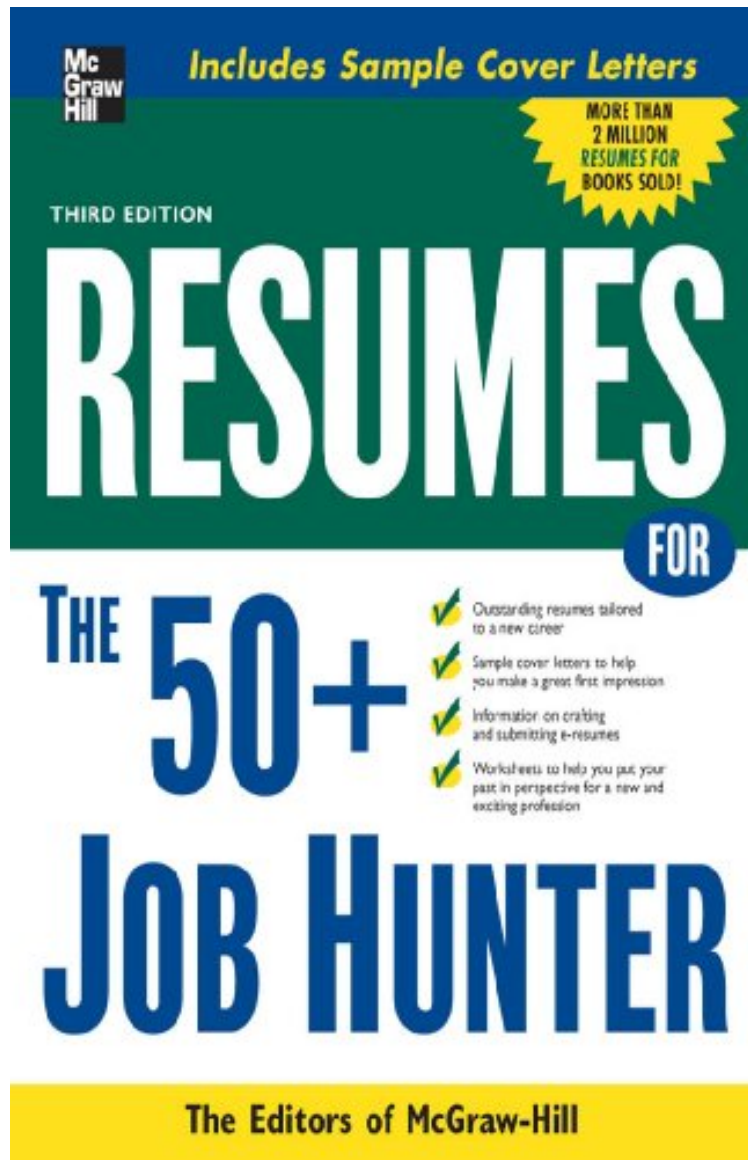

However, after a cursory review it does not seem like there is anything in this book which actually addresses those challenges. It simply presents information and resume formats which have

been widely published and available for a couple of decades. (As an aside; I did my review using Kindle for PC and have not tried to read it on my actual Kindle. Due to the presentation of sample Resumes in the book, this is a somewhat difficult to read on a PC screen so I imagine it would be extremely hard to read on a Kindle.) There are other books on the market that are better tools for updating or improving a resume. I also purchased "Resume Magic" which I found useful and would recommend. However, I have not found a good book that does address the difficulties facing a "more experienced" job hunter.
