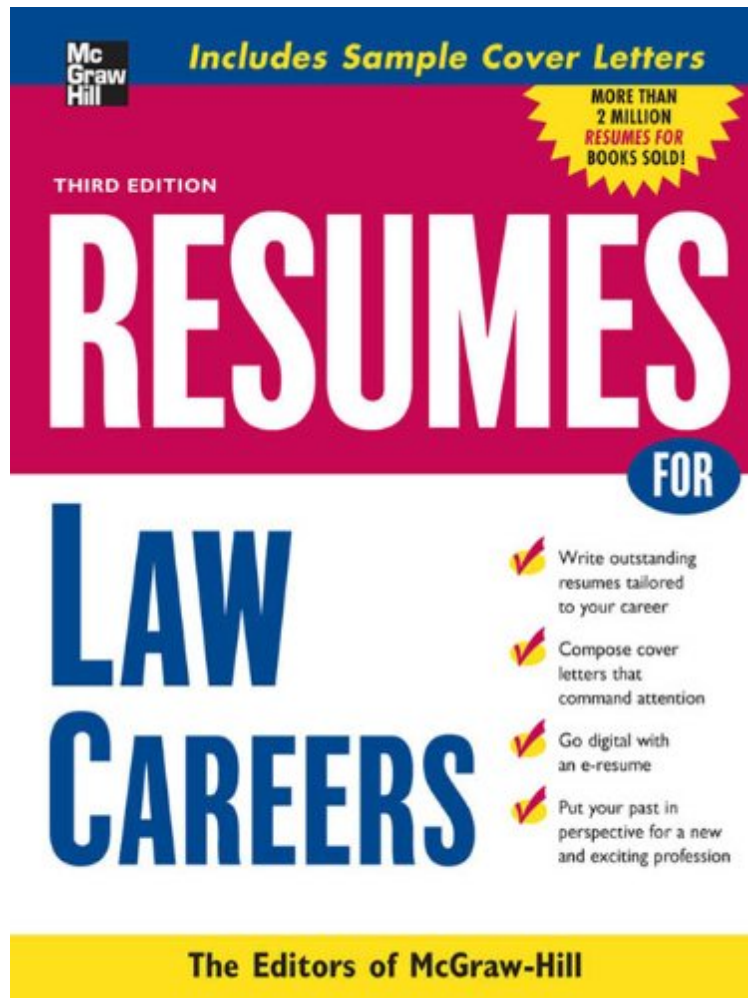

Out of 152 pages, 26 are text. The balance is worksheets(8), sample resumes (79), and cover letters (21). The sample resumes are mostly for recent grads. They are not categorized in any way, which means you're left to read through all of them to find any that might be comparable to your situation. If you do this, you will get an idea of how much time someone else will give your resume when THEY have to go through a thick pile. I can't see any other benefit you might derive from reading the samples because none of them are particularly well done (though I suppose they're adequate). Many don't conform to the suggestions in the book. On the whole the suggestions are good, but standard--not related to law careers. For example, in discussing "Assembly and Layout," the book suggests: "if you are applying for a position that requires ornamental illustration, you may want to include border illustrations or graphics that demonstrate your talents

in this area." And, "If you are answering an advertisement for a job that requires certain physical traits, a photo of yourself might be appropriate. A person applying for a job as a computer programmer would not include a photo as part of his or her resume."Neither, I suggest, would a lawyer.
