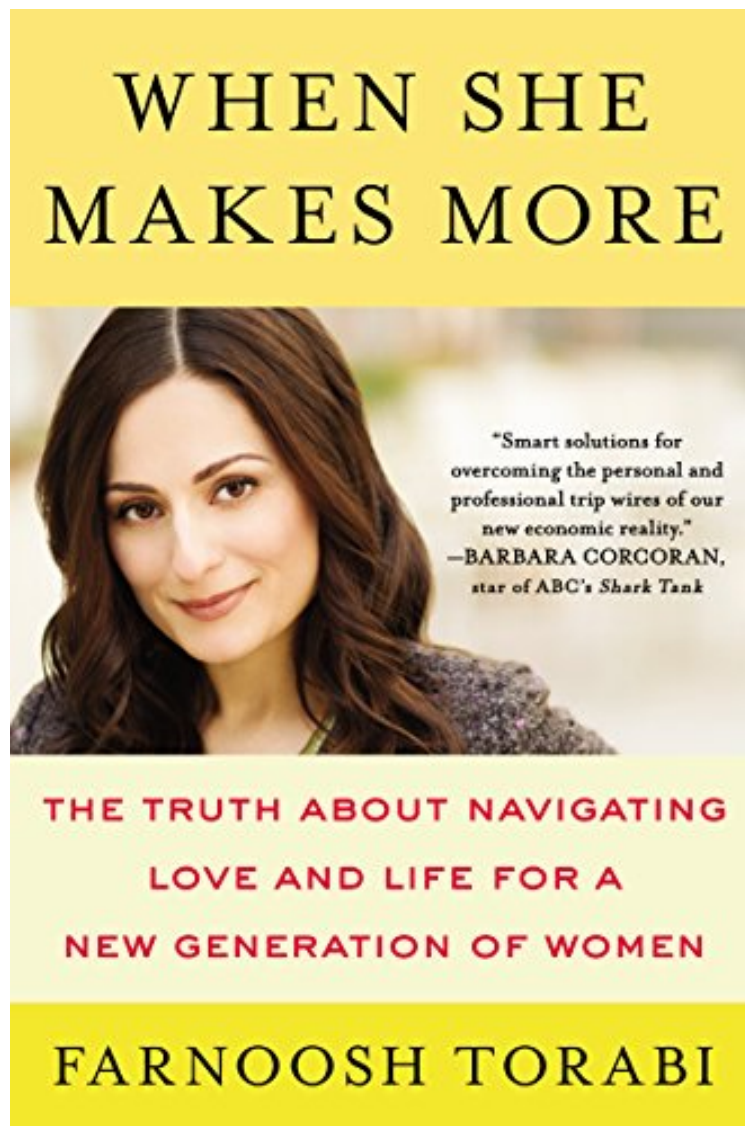

The financial suggestions are solid regardless (if a bit gendered/old-fashioned) but I applaud the author for tackling them just the same, since few others have come out with practical advice on the subject. Best advice in the book is to tackle a "Yours, Mine, Ours" spilt and, though it will be controversial to many, to think in terms of being available to your kids when they get a bit older, when they remember and need complicated guidance navigating friends, school and bullying -- rather than pulling your hair out trying to make staying at home work when an infants needs are comparatively simple. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
